The partnership between A Better Way, whose mission is to reduce domestic abuse, sexual assault, suicide and homelessness through service, shelter, crisis intervention and prevention initiatives, and LifeStream, ECI's Area Agency on Aging, will allow Telecare coverage to expand to include daily phone service, 7 days a week, 10 hours per day, throughout the counties of Delaware, Blackford, Fayette, Henry, Jay, Randolph, Union, and Wayne counties.

It will also allow LifeStream to refer individuals to A Better Way who may benefit from the Telecare service, as well as referrals into LifeStream for additional home- and community-based services for individuals already participating in the Telecare program.
